

Applying for a Portland Literacy Council GED Test Scholarship

The application is a Word Form file. If you have difficulty with the form, please email GED@portlandliteracy.org for assistance.

Applicants must be GED-ready and meet additional age and residency criteria to be considered for scholarships.

If awarded a scholarship, Portland Literacy Council will provide you with a voucher number to use as payment when scheduling a test. Vouchers expire one year from when they are issued.

Application Form Instructions

1. Enter data in the form:
 - a. Place the cursor in any shaded box and begin typing.
 - b. To go to the next field, use the **Tab** key.
 - c. Use this format dates for DD/MM/YYYY.
 - d. Use your best grammar and spelling.
2. Save the file as <GED Your Name>, for example: GED John Doe.doc
3. Keep a copy of the file for yourself. You may want to keep a printed copy in case your Email is not received.
4. Submit to Portland Literacy Council:
 - a. Compose an e-mail to: GED@portlandliteracy.org
 - b. Subject Line: GED Scholarship Application for <Your Name>
 - c. Attach a copy of your application file.
 - d. Include a brief message in the body of the email introducing yourself to Portland Literacy Council.

Scholarship Awards

- You can expect acknowledgement of your application from Portland Literacy Council within one week.
- You can expect a decision on whether you will receive a scholarship within two weeks.
